## \$5,000 up for grabs to help rural students

Suncorp has partnered with the Royal National Agricultural and Industrial Association (RNA) to offer rural students the opportunity to secure a \$5,000 bursary to assist with their studies.

Suncorp Head of Business Customers John Debenham said the 2016 Ekka Suncorp Bursary is now open to all existing Queensland University or TAFE students from rural or remote areas, who are currently living away from home.

For a chance to secure the bursary, students must prepare a short written application detailing how the money would assist in achieving their educational goals.
